

**DIRECTORATE OF MEDICAL EDUCATION, TELANGANA STATE**  
**GUIDELINES FOR RECRUITMENT OF SENIOR RESIDENTS IN**  
**GOVERNMENT MEDICAL COLLEGES IN TELANGANA STATE**

1. The selection of Senior Residents will be subject wise and college specific and it will be for a period of One Year Only.
2. The candidates should not have completed 39 years by 31<sup>st</sup> July 2018.
3. Only the candidates who have MD/MS/DNB degree along with additional qualification registered with Telangana State Medical Council are eligible.
4. DNB Candidates will be selected as per the latest existing MCI guidelines.
  - a) If DNB done from MCI recognized medical college, is eligible for SR.
  - b) If DNB done from other than MCI recognized medical college then 3 years as Junior Resident post DNB in a recognized medical college is mandatory.( proof in the form of 3 years of experience as JR and Bank salary statement/ Form-16 for the same 3 years)
5. A committee will be constituted at college level by Principal and should include Superintendent and three College council members. A Verification committee should also be constituted by the Principal of the College for verification of the certificates. The Selection of candidates will be as per the guidelines of Medical Council of India (MCI) prescribed for Senior Residents.
6. Marks scored in the PG theory examination will be the criteria for Selection. The local fresh batch students of Dr. NTRUHS should be given preference over others. In case more than one candidate is having the same theory marks in that particular batch, date of birth will be taken into consideration. The older person shall get first preference.
7. Rule of Reservation will be followed wherever number of posts are more than One, Subject wise.
8. Those candidates who have done PG as non-local candidates in Andhra Pradesh state and want to join as Senior Residents in Telangana state have to apply with No Objection Certificate (NOC) from Andhra Pradesh DME
9. The Application form will be available at [dme.telangana.gov.in](http://dme.telangana.gov.in) and also the respective college websites. Two filled in applications should be submitted along with Xerox copies of documents mentioned in point no. 10 as per the schedule mentioned below.
  - 9a) The cutoff date for submission of application forms for Osmania Medical College and Gandhi Medical College is **25<sup>th</sup> July 2018**, at office of the Principals of respective colleges. No applications for these two colleges will be entertained after the cutoff date.

Selected list of Senior Residents for Osmania and Gandhi Medical College will be prepared and displayed at respective college websites and DME website on 28<sup>th</sup> July 2018. These candidates should join the respective colleges on or before 1<sup>st</sup> August 2018.

9b) The cutoff dates for submission of application forms is **3<sup>rd</sup> August 2018** for the Colleges given below at the Office of the Principals of the respective colleges. No application will be entertained after the cutoff date.

Govt. Medical College, Siddipet  
Govt. Medical College, Mahaboobnagar  
Govt. Medical College, Nizamabad  
RIMS, Adilabad

Selected list of candidates of above mentioned Colleges will be prepared and displayed at the respective college websites and DME website on 7<sup>th</sup> August 2018 and these candidates should join on or before 10<sup>th</sup> August 2018.

10. The selected candidates shall bring along with them the following at the time of reporting at their respective colleges.
  - a) Aadhar Card.
  - b) Proof of Date of Birth (Aadhar/ SSC /Birth certificate)
  - c) Study/ Bonafide certificates 4<sup>th</sup> -10<sup>th</sup>
  - d) Original Marks Memo
  - e) Provisional/Original Degree
  - f) Bonafide/ Study certificate of PG/Super specialty Period.
  - g) Caste certificate for SC/ST/BC issued by competent authority, ( in case of SC/ST specifying caste, In case of BC's subgroup indicating A, B, C, D and E)
  - h) MBBS Registration from Telangana/AP Medical Council, additional PG qualification registration from Telangana State Medical Council only (without registration application will be rejected).
  - i) NOC from DME, AP if applicable is a must and should be produced at the time of counseling. MBBS study certificate from the TS local candidates who have taken unreserved PG seat in AP.
11. Selected candidates should submit their original certificates of Degree and Registration of both MBBS and MD/MS/DNB at the time of reporting which will be retained by the College authority for which custodian certificate will be issued by the college.
12. Candidate once selected and joined in any Government Medical College and if discontinues within One Year, he/she will not be allowed for any future selections also.
13. If a candidate wants to leave Senior Residency, he/she should give one month notice, following which only original documents will be returned.
14. All the selected candidates have to submit cancelled cheque with IFSC Code.
15. Accommodation will be provided where ever available.
